



Prize Competition

Terms and Conditions

1. The Promoter

The promoter is Genesis Motor Europe GmbH, a company incorporated in Germany (registration number HRB 53216) whose registered office is at Kaiserleipromenade 5, 63067 Offenbach am Main, Germany (the “**Promoter**”).

2. The Competition

The title of the competition is Genesis Scottish Open Hole in One Prize (15th hole).

3. The Prize

3.1. The “**Prize**” consists of two tickets to the Genesis Championship in Korea (the “**Tournament**”).

3.2. The Prize includes:

- (a) Entrance to the Tournament for two people for each day.
- (b) Roundtrip business class airfare from a major European airport for the Winner and one other person as nominated by the Winner. Flights may be either direct or indirect, dependant on the Winner’s home location.
- (c) Accommodation at a designated 4-star hotel in a twin or double hotel room at a designated Tournament hotel for four nights (including breakfast for two people), to be allocated by the Promoter.
- (d) Two VIP passes to the 18th hole Genesis hospitality lounge during the Tournament for each day of the Tournament.
- (e) Transportation from Incheon airport in Korea to the designated hotel.

3.3. The Winner may choose to extend the amount of time they stay in Korea, and as a result the airfare reservations may be adjusted according to such schedule, provided such schedule includes the Tournament period. Accommodation at the hotel will only be provided for the selected four nights. The departure and return airports must be the same.

3.4. The Prize is subject to availability. There is no cash alternative to the Prize.

3.5. Relevant taxes (if any) related to acquiring the Prize will be the responsibility of the Winner.

3.6. The Prize is not negotiable or transferable.

4. How to enter

4.1. At the 2026 Genesis Scottish Open, the Promoter will establish a competition in the event that any tournament player achieves a Hole in One.

4.2. Any person may enter the competition by registering for the 15th Hole in One competition using the online form available [here](#). Attendance at the tournament is not required, and no purchase is necessary.

4.3. Once the player field is set, fans will be able to sign-up via the online form to select the player that they think will make a Hole in One on the 6th hole during the GSO.

4.4. Fans will also have the chance to sign up and register on site, with the Promoter’s ambassadors directing attendees to the online registration form.

4.5. If a Hole in One is made on the 15th hole, any Entrant who selected that player more than 30 minutes before the Hole in One is officially recorded will be eligible to win the Prize.

4.6. If more than one Hole in One is made, the Prize will be awarded only in relation to the first counting Hole in One.

4.7. The winner will be selected at random by drawing lots from all Entrants having selected the player that scored the Hole in One on the 15th Hole during the GSO (the “**Winner**”).

4.8. By submitting a competition entry, you are agreeing to be bound by these terms and conditions.

5. Eligibility

5.1. All Entrants must be over the age of 18 years and must be permanent residents of either the United Kingdom, Germany or Switzerland.

5.2. All Entrants must provide contact details as part of their entry form, for the purpose of arranging the Prize.

5.3. All persons involved in the conception and implementation of the competition and employees of the organiser and affiliated companies as well as the relatives of such employees are not eligible to participate in the competition.



- 5.4. There is a limit of one entry to the competition per person. Entries on behalf of another person will not be accepted and joint submissions are not allowed.
- 5.5. Only the first Hole in One made will qualify for the Prize. After this first Hole in One, the competition is finished, and no further prizes will be awarded. Any hole in one made during a practice round, Pro-Am round or extra play-off holes will not count.
- 5.6. The Hole in One score for the 15th hole must be recorded and signed for on the player's official tournament scorecard and verified by the Genesis Scottish Open Championship Director or equivalent.
- 5.7. The Hole in One must be part of a completed tournament round. If the player is disqualified or withdraws from the competition, the Hole in One will not count as an eligible hole in one for the purposes of winning the Prize.
- 5.8. Each Entrant may select only one player.
- 5.9. The Promoter may disqualify any Entrant from the competition if the Entrant's conduct is contrary to the spirit of the competition or might harm the Promoter's reputation. Such reasons include, in particular, manipulation in connection with the competition, violations of these conditions of participation, unfair conduct, or false or misleading information in connection with participation in the competition.
- 5.10. If there is a dispute about the Prize, eligibility or these rules, the Promoter's decision is final.

6. Winners

- 6.1. The decision of the Promoter is final and no correspondence or discussion will be entered into.
- 6.2. The Promoter will contact the Winner of the Prize Within one week of the first counting hole in one by email and/or phone call.
- 6.3. The Winner will receive their tickets directly by post, where the Winner will need to sign for delivery. The Promoter will not be responsible for the inability of a Prize winner to take up the Prize.
- 6.4. The Promoter will send the name and geographic region of the Winners to anyone who writes within one month after the Closing Date of the competition requesting details of the Winner and who encloses a self-addressed envelope to the address set out in Condition 1.

7. Claiming the Prize

- 7.1. Please allow 40 days for delivery of the Prize.
- 7.2. The Promoter will make all reasonable efforts to contact the Winner. If the Winner cannot be contacted or is not available, or has not claimed the Prize within 5 days of the announcement date, the Promoter reserves the right to offer the Prize to the next eligible Entrant selected from the correct entries that were received before the Closing Date.

- 7.3. The Promoter does not accept any responsibility if you are not able to take up the Prize.

8. Limitation of Liability

Insofar as is permitted by law, the Promoter, its agents or distributors will not in any circumstances be responsible or liable to compensate the Winner or accept any liability for any loss, damage, personal injury or death occurring as a result of taking up the Prize except where it is caused by the negligence of the Promoter, its agents or distributors or that of their employees. Your statutory rights are not affected.

9. Ownership of Competition Entries and Intellectual Property Rights

- 9.1. All competition entries and any accompanying material submitted to the Promoter will become the property of the Promoter on receipt and will not be returned.
- 9.2. By submitting your competition entry and any accompanying material, you agree to:
 - (a) assign to the Promoter all your intellectual property rights with full title guarantee; and
 - (b) waive all moral rights,in and to your competition entry and otherwise arising in connection with your entry to which you may now or at any time in the future be entitled under the UK Copyright, Designs and Patents Act 1988 as amended from time to time and under all similar legislation from time to time in force anywhere in the world.

10. Data Protection and Publicity

- 10.1. The Promoter will only process your personal information as set out in the [link [Privacy Notice](#)].

11. General

- 11.1. If there is any reason to believe that there has been a breach of these terms and conditions, the Promoter may, at its sole discretion, reserve the right to exclude you from participating in the competition.
- 11.2. The Promoter reserves the right to hold void, suspend, cancel, or amend the Prize competition where it becomes necessary to do so.
- 11.3. These terms and conditions shall be governed by English law, and the parties submit to the non-exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of England and Wales.
